

## **68th Annual Spring Wildflower Pilgrimage Registration Tips.**

### **Please read carefully.**

Before you begin the registration process, please look over the Brochure or Spreadsheet of Events and plan the days for each person you will register. Page 4 of the Brochure contains a good template for planning for each person.

### **Online Registration**

- Opens 10AM Eastern on Thursday, March 1<sup>st</sup>.
- A Registration Button will be added to the Wildflower Pilgrimage website.
- Registration badge can be mailed to you this year. Approximately one week prior to event, badges will be sent to the address provided. If you will be traveling before this date, then please notify us (there is a box in the registration process) at registration so we can send your badge early or to a different address.
- Duplicate badges are NOT available onsite.
- Printable brochure located on website.
- Printed brochures are available at onsite registration desk.

### **Onsite Registration**

- Begins at 5PM Eastern Tuesday, April 24<sup>th</sup> at the Mills Conference Center in Gatlinburg, Tennessee.
- With onsite registration you pick up your badge and printed brochure at the registration desk.
- Please come to registration desk with a plan for your registration, including 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and even 3<sup>rd</sup> options as events may be sold out to online registrants. You should pick 1, 2, 3<sup>rd</sup> options in case the first option is sold out.

### **Registering Multiple People**

- Each person in your party needs an independent registration and schedule of events. Individuals can register separately, or one person can register everyone together with a combined payment.
- Your confirmation number will allow you to make any changes to your registration at any time prior to the week of the event.
- If your updated schedule differs from your badge, please provide current confirmation at the trailhead

### **Cancellation Policy**

- We sincerely appreciate your support of this event and its mission to bring biologists and conservationists into contact with the public in one of the most biodiverse areas of North America. Due to financial commitments to vendors, partners, sponsors, and facilities, refunds are NOT provided.
